 Callaway have by several Orders of Court been Appointed Trustees for the
 said to be made to them in Trust for the County Now This Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said William Callaway for & in Consideration of the sum
 of five Shillings current Money The Receipt whereof he doth hereby Ackno-
 wledge hath given granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Enfeoffed & Confirmed
 to the said William Mead, Richard Stith & Richard Callaway Trustees
 as aforesaid their Heirs & Assigns forever all that Piece Parcel or Lot of Land
 containing fifty Acres which is Laid off in Lots in the Town of New Lond-
 on in the said County & adjoining the fifty Acres whereon the Court house
 is Erected which was formerly granted to the said County by the said
 Callaway according to his Agreement, the said Land being Part of a
 Tract of five Hundred & Thirty Acres of Land granted to the said Callaw-
 ay by Patent Bearing Date the Twenty fourth Day of March one Thou-
 sand Seven Hundred Sixty seven together with all and singular the
 Priviledges & Appurtenances to the same Belonging or in anywise
